

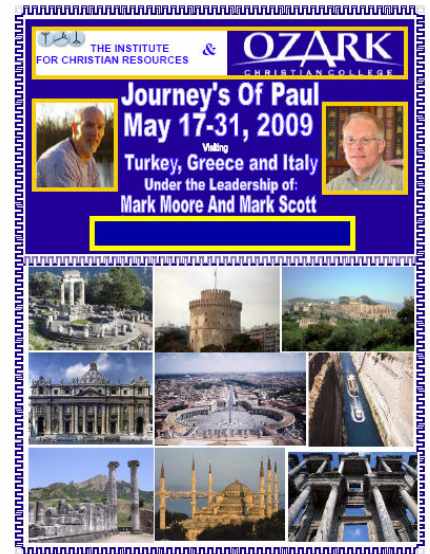

**Turkey, Greece and Italy.**

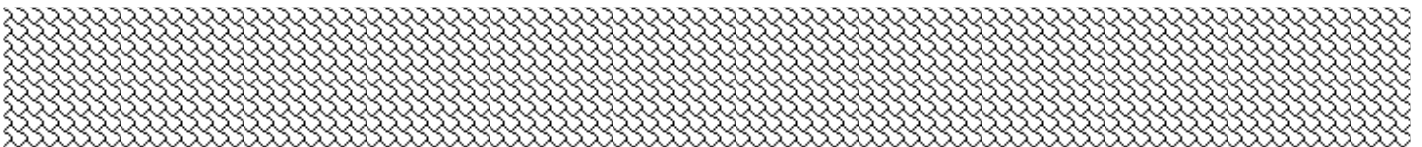


Come with us in spirit and follow along as we travel in Paul's footsteps.

# Pauline Mission Tour Preparation Guide

**Purpose:** This trip is designed specifically so that participants will be able to construct a biblically founded philosophy and methodology of missions by retracing the steps of Paul.

**Expectations:** You are expected to understand the culture, philosophy, geography, architecture, and sociology of Paul’s day in order to correctly interpret and apply his mission strategy in the various cultural environments you will enter.
